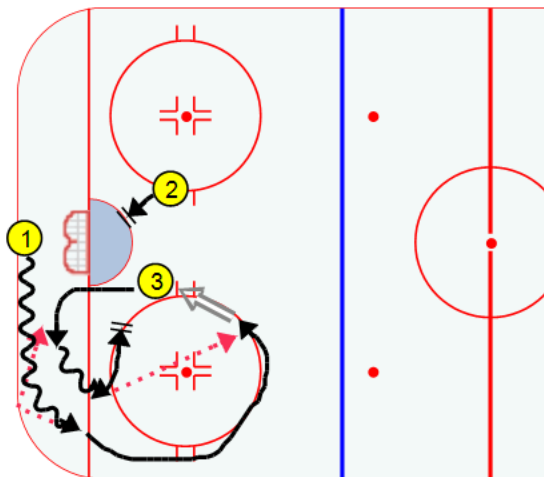


**Description**

Players start as shown with the puck behind the net.  
 In this drill 2 & 3 must "read" the play and determine which offensive attack will work best.  
 In the first example 1 skates up the wall and drops the puck down low where 3 picks it up and looks for 1 coming around the circle.  
 2 gets to the net for tips and rebounds.  
 3 must get back inside after the pass is complete

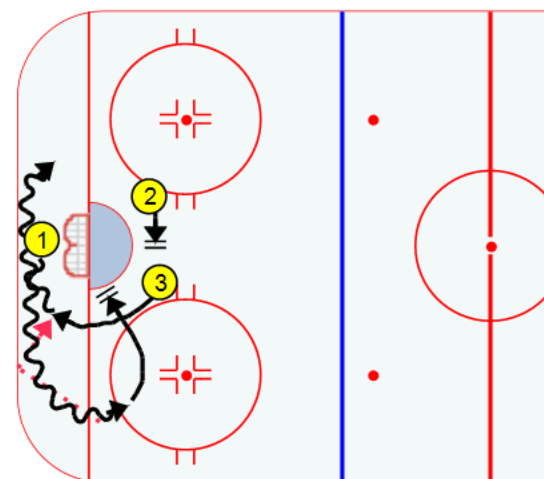

**Description**

In this example 3 picks up the puck down low and cust behind the net.  
 1 & 2 must "read" that 3 has gone behind the net and move to make themselves available for passes.  
 1 cuts back inside while 2 moves to the low slot area  
 3 can now either pass or skate out and shoot
